<p><b>Friday, November 17</b>  <b>Build PVC Base</b>  <b>9:00 am - 4:00 pm</b>          We need 112 volunteers (28 teams of 4) to build 28 PVC 10'x10' pods and position them on the field to form the 110"x50" base in preparation for blanket placement on November 18.</p>	<p><b>Friday, November 17</b>  <b>Blanket Preparation</b>  <b>9:00 am - 1:00 pm</b>          We need a total of 56 volunteers to assist with 1) loading donated blankets onto truck at storage unit for transport to Toyota Field, 2) unloading blankets from truck to staging area at Toyota Field, and 3) sorting and prepping of blankets for placement on Saturday morning.</p>	<p><b>Saturday, November 18</b>  <b>Hanging of Blankets</b>  <b>8:00 am - 1:00 pm</b>          We need 112 volunteers (28 teams of 4) to cover PVC base with 56 sections of connected blankets (30' lengths). To qualify for the Guinness World Record, the entire blanket fort must be completely covered.</p>	<p><b>Saturday, November 18</b>  <b>End of Event Breakdown</b>  <b>2:00 pm - 4:00 pm</b>          After the festivities are over, we need 56 volunteers to help us: 1) remove, separate and box up the blankets to go to Haven for Hope and 2) separate, sort and stack the PVC pipe and connectors to go to Habitat for Humanity.</p>
